What types of aircraft are available?



To guarantee the ultimate air travel experience, V-One provides you with immediate access to the widest range of high-quality aircraft 7 days a week 24 hours a day.

Unless you have a specific aircraft type in mind, our team will recommend a selection of aircraft based on your requirements, but here is the range of aircraft types available to you categorised into four groups:

Jets

- Light Executive Jets:** Small fast jets with a good range and 5-8 seats
- Midsized Executive Jets:** Medium sized jets with medium to long range, some with stand up cabins and 6-10 seats
- Heavy Executive Jets:** Large, very spacious, luxurious jets with 8-16 seats
- Regional Jets:** Short haul range, modern jets with 37-110 seats



Airliners

- Narrow Body Airliners:** Modern, popular jet airliners with 104-220 seats
- Wide Body Airliners:** Modern, medium to long range jets with up to 680 seats
- VIP Executive Airliners:** Very modern VIP configured corporate jet airliners with long range and 12-100 seats



Turboprops

- Regional Turboprops:** Modern, fast commuter turboprop aircraft with up to 78 seats
- Executive Turboprops:** Fast, twin-propeller aircraft with 8-29 seats



Helicopters

- Single Engine Helicopter:** Single turbine engine helicopters with up to 6 seats
- Twin Engine Helicopter:** Twin turbine engine helicopters with up to 30 seats



Making An Enquiry



When you contact us to enquire about chartering an aircraft, we will ask you a number of questions to help us recommend the best solution to your travel needs.

We need to know

- Your planned travel dates
- Where your passengers are coming from (we may be able to use a airport closer to them)
- Whether you're looking for a one way charter, a day trip, an overnight or multi-sector flight
- Where you want to fly from and to
- How many passengers there will be

We will also ask

- What type of trip you are planning? – e.g. business, VIP, celebration, sporting - as this will allow us to recommend the most appropriate aircraft
- How much luggage you are planning to have?

Note : Unless you are chartering an airliner, there are some luggage guidelines to consider. Each aircraft type has its own baggage restrictions and we will advise you of these prior to your departure. As a rule you can follow the following:

- Light = One bag per person
- Heavy = Skis, golf bags, 2 or more bags per person
- Do any of your passengers have any disabilities?
- Do any of your passengers have special dietary requirements?
- Do you have an aircraft preference?
- Do you have a budget in mind?
- Do you require any external or internal aircraft branding?
- Whether you are looking to take any pets, as there are certain considerations

How To Make A Booking



Once you've considered the options presented in our comprehensive air charter proposal, you're only a call away from making a booking and confirming the flight.

Once you've confirmed your booking verbally we follow an industry standard procedure, which is designed to protect you and us.

Step by Step Procedure

- 1) You call and confirm that you wish to go ahead with the flight.
- 2) We e-mail you our charter agreement – this needs to be signed and returned.
- 3) Once we receive the signed charter agreement, the aircraft is booked and flight confirmation is sent to you by email.
- 4) The cancellation policy is now in force to protect both parties.
- 5) Any additional requirements, services (e.g. branding of aircraft) can also be arranged.

Please note: If you're a new client, then payment will need to be made prior to the flight. We accept all major credit and debit cards or CHAPS bank transfer.

We Advise You

- The point of embarkation (normally a VIP business lounge away from the main terminals)
- The planned time of departure as per your request
- Luggage restrictions (if any)
