A SAFER WAY TO TRAVEL

Flying top executives to business meetings around the globe is commonplace. However, most of these executives are flying either first class or business class on scheduled airlines. This can cause problems in itself – private conversations are no longer private, you are distracted by other passengers and you still have to check in two hours before your departure time and are subject to the same delays as the passengers in standard class.

There is an alternative but it is one that is often thought of as too expensive and generally only used as a last resort. Chartering an aircraft is not as expensive as you might think. But for important business people it isn't really all about the cost saving. The biggest savings can be made on time when you charter an aircraft. Because you only need to check in 30 minutes before you are due to fly, you will have an instant saving of 1 hour and 30 minutes at both ends of your journey.

Add into the equation that you can also travel from an airport that is more convenient for you and land at an airport that is closer to your final destination then you have a real time benefit to chartering.

For example:

Travelling from London City to Geneva takes 2 hours and 20 minutes each way including check in time with a chartered flight. The travel time increases to 6 hours and 35 minutes on the way out and 5 hours and 20 minutes on the way back when you travel with scheduled airlines.

Travelling from London City to Oslo takes 3 hours and 20 minutes each way including check in time with a chartered flight. The travel time increases to 6 hours and 25 minutes on the way out and 5 hours and 50 minutes on the way back when you travel with scheduled airlines.

In addition to this time saving you can also choose the time you fly when you charter a plane and are not restricted by the rigorous schedules set by airlines.

In terms of safety there is no better way to fly than by chartered aircraft. The only luggage on board belongs to your party and discretion is guaranteed. Check in time is much shorter – only 15 minutes rather than the standard two hours. And there is no risk of getting left behind as the flight can wait for late arrivals, unlike a scheduled airline. Once on board you will be in an environment conducive to working with few interruptions – there really is no better way to travel for business.
